Access model. The journal publishes all articles under full open access (gold OA). The Version of Record (VoR) of each article is distributed under the Creative Commons CC BY 4.0 license (non-commercial and commercial use with attribution). Full license text:

What CC BY 4.0 permits.

Any user may read, store, share, copy, and adapt the material for non-commercial and commercial purposes provided that they:

- credit the authors, the journal, and the DOI;
- indicate the CC BY 4.0 license and link to it;
- indicate if changes were made.

Commercial use.

Any use not covered by CC BY 4.0 requires written permission from the publisher (info@positive-science.com).

Third-party content.

Images, figures, tables, or data owned by third parties must carry proper credits and/or separate terms (if they are not covered by CC BY 4.0). Obtaining permissions is the authors' responsibility.

Self-archiving.

Authors may immediately deposit the VoR (PDF/HTML) in institutional/subject repositories and on personal sites, provided the DOI, journal, and CC BY 4.0 license are cited.

Preprints.

Preprint posting before and during peer review is permitted. After publication, authors should update the preprint record with the article DOI and the final license.

Data and code.

We encourage releasing datasets and code under open licenses compatible with non-commercial reuse (e.g., CC BY/CC0 for data; MIT/BSD/GPL for code). Where access is restricted (confidential/licensed data), this must be explained transparently in the Data/Code Availability Statement.

Text & data mining (TDM).

Non-commercial and commercial TDM is permitted under CC BY 4.0, with attribution and links to the DOI/license.
